Note that, doing any change in the users system. Always backup the regedit, and then follow these steps:

1. Hit the **Windows Key + R** shortcut on your keyboard.
2. Type **regedit** and hit **Enter** on your keyboard.
3. Double-click **HKEY_CURRENT_USER**.
4. Double-click **SOFTWARE**.
5. Double-click **Microsoft**.
6. Double-click **Windows**.
7. Double-click **CurrentVersion**.
8. Double-click **Search**.
9. Right-click the **right pane** of the RegEdit window to bring up the menu.
10. Click **New**.
11. Click **D-WORD (32-bit) Value**.
12. Type **BingSearchEnabled** and hit **Enter** on your keyboard.
13. Double-click the **BingSearchEnabled** entry you just created.
14. Type **0** in the Value data field. (It should already be 0 but make sure)
15. Click **OK**.
16. Double-click **CortanaConsent**.
17. Type **0** in the data field. (It should also already be 0 but make sure).
18. Click **OK**.
19. Restart your **PC**.
